Vegetable Soup Recipe



What you need to do:



Cut the ends off the onion, then pull the skin off. Chop the onion into small pieces.



Cut the ends off the carrot, then peel it. Chop the carrot into small pieces.



Wash the leek and then cut off the ends.

Chop the leek into small pieces.



Peel the potato and chop it into small pieces.



Cut the ends off the 2 celery sticks. Chop them into small pieces.



Put the bowl on the scales and weigh 25g of butter.



Add the butter to the saucepan and let it melt. Add all the vegetables but NOT the potatoes. Keep stirring for about 5 minutes.



Weigh out 25g of flour



Add the flour to the saucepan and stir for 5 minutes



Put the stock cube into the jug with the hot water and stir it until it mixes with the water.

Then add this to the saucepan.



Add the potatoes to the saucepan. Cook for 30 minutes with it slightly bubbling, this is called simmering.



After 30 minutes your soup should be ready.

Put it in a bowl and enjoy.


